

Elementary School Social Worker/Counselor

The Soulard School, a charter elementary school located in the Soulard neighborhood, seeks a full-time Student & Family Support Coordinator for the 2024-25 school year to manage social-emotional programs and student and family support systems in alignment with the school's mission and philosophy. This position would be suitable for someone who is a school social worker and/or a school counselor.

This position is a full-time school-year salaried position starting August 8, 2024.

Major Responsibilities:

- Provide comprehensive social work services to parents, students and staff
- Provide crisis prevention/intervention services, and support restorative conversations and conflict resolution
- Respond to referrals from school staff/parents by providing direct services
- Assist families in accessing appropriate school and community resources.
- Teach weekly social-emotional learning lessons to elementary classes
- Assist in developing positive behavioral intervention strategies/plans
- Support the school day with other support duties such as lunch and recess supervision on an agreed upon schedule
- Work with school administrators to provide additional learning opportunities for parents and staff such as workshops and professional development.
- Serve as the school's Homeless Liaison and Migrant Coordinator.
- Support the Special Education team with IEP implementation as appropriate.

Education and Experience:

- Bachelor's Degree with major field of study or degree emphasis in school social work or school counseling required
- Licensed as a School Social Worker by the Missouri Division of Professional Registration, or other state licensing agency, or certified as a School Counselor by the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education or other state licensing agency required

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• Working knowledge of the principles, practices, and ethical standards of School Social Work & School Counseling; the relevant state and federal laws, rules and regulations, and applicable policies.

Required Skills and Abilities

- Warm and supportive attitude and disposition toward working with children and their families.
- Reliable in attendance.
- Willing to accept supervision in order to improve work performance.
- Have excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Physically able to perform the job of a teacher of young children.
- Ability to respond effectively and appropriately with students, parents, and educational professionals regarding students.
- Ability to consult and collaborate with school personnel in developing and implementing strategic interventions and plans.
- Ability to be flexible and prioritize activities.

General Pay and Contract Provisions

- 40 hour work week with hours between 8:00 am and 4:00 pm
- School year to run mid-August through early June
- Health and retirement benefits including participation in Public School Retirement System of St. Louis pension plan
- Starting salary range \$55,000 to \$60,000 depending on education and experience
