- 1. Welcome, Intros & Opening Comments
- 2. Board development
 - a. Proposed new board member Ron Kampwerth, CFO of Together Credit Union
 - b. Pier Alsup was prior board member from Credit Union
 - c. Approved unanimously
- 3. Review and approve December meeting notes *approved unanimously* (Basiyr and Ron abstaining as they were not present at last meeting)
- 4. Board Training
 - a. Basiyr & Steve to hold special session on Title IX and Sunshine Laws
 - b. 1/27, 12:00-1:00
 - c. Zoom invite to follow
- 5. Board Summit in March to include TSS and SEC boards
 - a. 4-6 hour day to work through groundwork for creating strategic plan

 - a. MAP testing
 - i. Our 3-5th graders will test for the first time, since it was canceled last year
 - ii. What do we know from DESE?
 - 1. They are planning on testing
 - 2. They are pushing for in-person testing as much as possible
 - 3. Data will be used primarily for individual student performance, as well as schoolwide performance and sub-group performance (advanced, basic, below basic, remedial)
 - iii. What do we not know?
 - 1. What if parents refuse to send kids to school for testing?
 - a. Will school have to send proctor to the home?
 - 2. How will DESE use the data to assess schools/districts?
 - 3. How will they measure student growth w/o 2020 data?

- a. Definitely can't do for TSS because this will be our first time we will get 3 years before DESE can calculate APR scores
- iv. Covid severely disrupted all schools' delivery model will largely be negative effect on student growth/performance, especially relating to rising inequities
- v. Low test scores can have much more negative impact on charters than district schools, so as a charter board, need to be paying attention to policies on this
- vi. Suggesting parent letters:
 - 1. #1 Notify 3-5th grade families about testing purpose, process, schedule, parent role, etc.
 - 2. #2 Communicate to all families in summer about how test results will be posted in paper, etc.
 - 3. #3 Letter to send to individual parents to accompany their test scores explain what report says about their kid
- 8. School updates
 - a. Welcomed 3-4th graders back in January
 - i. 5th grade staying 100% virtual for 4th
 - b. Continuing to track covid and do on-campus rapid tests if needed
 - i. Have administered 12 Binax rapid tests so far all negative
 - ii. No evidence of in-school transmission, no large groups having to quarantine
 - c. Assessment Shenika
 - i. Currently doing second round of STAR and dyslexia testing
 - d. Special Education updates
 - i. Coordinator hired Kate Brothers
 - ii. Will provide Zoom intro to community
 - e. Admissions and planning for 2021-22
 - i. Currently have 65 applicants for enrollment for next year
 - ii. Have offered virtual tours to reach out to families
 - iii. Dr. Echols recently notified charters that it is likely that there will continue to be restrictions due to covid into the fall
 - 1. School will work to consider how to expand in-person learning safely
- 9. Financial updates Shannon
 - a. Review financial dashboard and cashflow
 - b. December SEC donation to TSS \$67,000
 - c. Shannon to review documents more with Ron prior to budget committee meeting
 - d. Currently wrapping up independent audit
 - i. Will need to do special session before end of month to review/approve audit
